#### PROPOSED RESOLUTION

The Fairbanks Chapter has voted to add this proposed resolution to the Resolution Platform:

The (Alaska State) Ag Covenant Regulations should be amended to include:

- 1. Subdivision We support farmers to be able to subdivide their land into 40 acre parcels as many times as they can or want, at any time they want.
- 2. Housing Rights Each subdivided 40-acre ag parcel will come with a housing right that does not have to be purchased from the state.
- 3. State Farm Conservation Plans These plans should be required only for new farms and farmers, either through the subdivision process in the sale of ag covenant land by farmers and new parcels. Farm conservation plans only have value for new farms created by one of these two processes. Subsequent farm conservation plans are not necessary for existing farms. Currently, farmers must have approval from the Division of Agriculture to clear land, build homes and outbuildings, roads and other development.

This resolution will be voted on at the November 16, 2013 Alaska Farm Bureau Annual Meeting that will be held at Chena Hot Springs Resort in Fairbanks. Copies of this proposed resolution will be available at the Annual Meeting. The current Resolution Platform has not been amended since the 2010 Annual Meeting. Bill Burton Memorial: The Kodiak Farm Bureau Chapter recently finalized their memorial to Bill Burton. The rock and bronze plaque were placed just outside the entrance gate to the fairground. The Alaska Farm Bureau donated the plaque and the Kodiak Farm Bureau Chapter donated and made arrangements for the rock, it's placement and the flower garden. The plaque reads: "In memory of Bill Burton in appreciation for his many years of support and service to Alaska

agriculture. Kodiak and Alaska Farm Bureaus."

Bill was a founding member of the Alaska Farm Bureau and served on the Board of Directors and as president of the Kodiak Farm Bureau Chapter for a number of years. He was active in the Kodiak Stock Growers Association, an original incorporator for the Kodiak Soil and Water Conservation District, a member of the Kodiak Livestock Cooperative that built the slaughter facility and participated, organized or was a member of everything related to agriculture on Kodiak Island and in Alaska for over 50 years. Bill passed away in October 2012, leaving his son, Buck and wife Kathy. They had celebrated their 50<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary just days before he died.

#### **BOARD OF DIRECTORS NOMINATIONS**

The Alaska Farm Bureau's election process begins next month when the nomination petitions will be mailed. The Board of Directors make most of the decisions and determinations of how the Farm Bureau will be administered.

There are six Farm Bureau Chapters in the state. The Fairbanks, Delta, Mat-Su and Kenai Peninsula Chapters each have two Directors. The Copper River Valley and Kodiak Chapters each have one Director. Directors have a two-year term of office. Directors with expiring terms this year are:
